Notice of 14-day public comment period from June 29 through July 12

and

Public Hearing on July 11, 2017 for the Draft 2017 Annual Action Plan  
for the CDBG and HOME Programs

The City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare an Annual Action Plan detailing the use of CDBG and HOME funds during the FY 2017, as part of the funding requirements for the Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Program.

As a result of the appropriations bill being signed into law later than usual, HUD was unable to released CPD formula allocations for entitlement grantee until June 14, 2017. In order to address potential issues with meeting the statutory August 16, 2017 submission deadline, HUD has issued a waiver of the regulatory 30-day citizen participation public comment period for states and local jurisdictions, in favor of a minimum 14-day comment period. This waiver applies to all CPD grantees, including those only submitting plans for HOME, ESG or HOPWA funding.

The City will receive \$1,295,836 in federal entitlement for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and \$304,806 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME).

A fourteen (14) day public comment period begins June 29 and will extend to July 12, 2017. Copies of the draft 2017 Annual Action Plan and proposed amendment of the CDBG & HOME budgets are available for review at the Dept. of Development and City Clerk's office, City Hall, 515 North Avenue; the New Rochelle Public Library, Library Plaza; and on the City's website at [www.newrochelleny.com](http://www.newrochelleny.com).

A Public Hearing will be held on **July 11, 2017 at 7:00 PM** in City Council Chambers, City Hall, 515 North Avenue regarding the draft 2017 Action Plan and amendments to the 2017 CDBG & HOME budgets.

City Council will act on the budget proposals and authorize submission of the 2017 Annual Action Plan at the regular legislative meeting on July 18, 2017.

The City of New Rochelle will make reasonable accommodations and services necessary for sensory-impaired and disabled citizens at the Public Hearings. Additionally, translation services may be offered upon request and availability. Persons requiring such accommodations/services should contact the City at least five working days in advance of the hearing.
