Notice of 30-day public comment period  
from June 13 through July 13, 2018  
and Public Hearing on July 10, 2018 for the  
Draft 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018 Annual Action Plan  
and amendments to the 2018 CDBG & HOME budgets

The City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare a 5-year Consolidated Plan. The Plan indicates how anticipated funds received from HUD will be implemented over 2018-2022 for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs. A draft 2018 Annual Action Plan, the first-year implementation of Consolidated Plan, details the use of CDBG and HOME funds during the FY 2018 as part of the funding requirements.

A thirty (30) day public comment period begins June 13 and will extend to July 13, 2018. Copies of the draft 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan, 2018 Annual Action Plan and amendments of the CDBG & HOME budgets are available for review at the Department of Development and City Clerk's office, City Hall, 515 North Avenue; the New Rochelle Public Library, Library Plaza; and on the City's website at [www.newrochelleny.com](http://www.newrochelleny.com). Written comments will be received through July 13, 2018 and may be sent to Adam Salgado, Operations Manager, City Hall, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, NY 10801; or email: [Asalgado@newrochelleny.com](mailto:Asalgado@newrochelleny.com).

A Public Hearing will be held on July 10, 2018 at 7:00 PM in City Council Chambers, City Hall, 515 North Avenue regarding the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan, 2018 Action Plan and amendments to the 2018 CDBG & HOME budgets.

City Council is expected to act on the proposals and authorize submission of the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018 Action Plan at the regular legislative meeting on July 17, 2018.

The City will make reasonable accommodations and services necessary for sensory-impaired and disabled citizens at the public meeting. Translation services may be offered upon request and availability.
