PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Notice of 30-day Public Comment Period  
from May 12, 2020 through June 11, 2020  
and Virtual Public Hearing on June 09, 2020 for the  
Draft 2020 Annual Action Plan and  
Amendments to the 2020 CDBG & HOME Budgets

The City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare an Annual Action Plan detailing the use of CDBG and HOME funds during the FY 2020 as part of the funding requirements for the Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Program.

A thirty (30) day public comment period begins May 12 and will extend to June 11, 2020. Copies of the draft 2020 Annual Action Plan and amendments of the CDBG & HOME budgets are available for review at the Department of Development and City Clerk's office at City Hall, 515 North Avenue; the New Rochelle Public Library, Library Plaza; and on the City's website at [www.newrochelleny.com](http://www.newrochelleny.com). In the event that City Hall and the Public Library are still closed to the public, due to the COVID-19 Emergency Declaration, copies of the aforementioned documents will be mailed or emailed upon written request. Written comments and document requests will be received through June 11, 2020 and may be sent to Todd Castaldo, Operations Manager, City Hall, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, NY 10801; or email: [tcastald@newrochelleny.com](mailto:tcastald@newrochelleny.com).

Under HUD guidelines, the City is required to conduct in person public hearings in order to provide for public participation. Since the City is under a state of emergency in which public gatherings are not possible, the City will hold a Virtual Public Hearing, via WebEx, on June 09, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. regarding the 2020 Action Plan and Amendments to the 2020 CDBG & HOME Budgets. All wishing to provide oral comments will be required to register by 1:45 p.m. on June 9<sup>th</sup>. Registration emails should be sent to [tcastald@newrochelleny.com](mailto:tcastald@newrochelleny.com), and should include the participants full name, physical address, email address and phone number. Mr. Castaldo will confirm receipt of participants registration following submission and provide further information on the public comment procedure. The Public Hearing will be broadcasted on the City's website and on the City's cable public access channel on television (Optimum Channel 75/Verizon Channel 28).

City Council is expected to act on the proposals and authorize submission of the 2020 Action Plan at the regular legislative meeting on June 16, 2020.

The City will make reasonable accommodations and services necessary for sensory-impaired and disabled citizens at the public meeting. Translation services may be offered upon request and availability.
