The City of New Rochelle is now accepting applications for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the 2021 Program Year. Qualified non-profit organizations providing eligible public service activities to New Rochelle residents are invited to apply.

The City of New Rochelle receives an annual allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) monies from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to fund projects and programs targeting low- and moderate-income persons. The City's priority needs include youth services, senior services, services for the disabled, employment training, fair housing programs, homeless and homeless prevention programs.
