

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**  
**Notice of 30-day Public Comment Period**  
**from February 15, 2023 through March 16, 2023**  
**and a Public Hearing on March 14, 2023, for Substantial Amendments to the**  
**2018 to 2022 Annual Action Plans and Budgets RE: Reprogram of funding**

In accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan, as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), substantial program amendments as a result of a change to the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, requires an amendment and allows for a 30-day Public Comment Period and Public Hearing. The City is reprogramming approximately \$1.4M of CDBG funds, originally allocated to Administration, Public Services, re-established Public Facilities and previously closed projects, to help fund shovel ready projects that will provide meaningful impact to the people who live and work in New Rochelle. A 30-day public comment period will extend from February 15, 2023 through March 16, 2023.
