2013-2017 Draft Consolidated Plan, 2013 Action Plan and
Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice
for Community Development Block Grant and HOME Programs

The City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare a five-year Consolidated Plan covering years 2013 through 2017 which identifies the City's needs and investments in housing, homelessness, community development and economic development, public service programs, infrastructure improvements, and the construction and preservation of affordable housing. The City's Consolidated Plan also describes the City's 5-year strategies for the use of the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funds which will be used to accomplish the goals of the Consolidated Plan. The Annual Action Plan, detailing the use of CDBG and HOME funds during FY 2013, and, the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice which was updated during the Consolidated Plan process, must also be included in the submission to HUD. In accordance with HUD requirements, the City Council will hold a public hearing on **October 10, 2012** to provide citizens, interested agencies and non-profits an opportunity to comment on these documents at:
