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LPG INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

- INSTALLER MUST FILL OUT APPLICATION AND SUBMIT IT ALONG WITH REQUIRED FEE AND A SITE PLAN DETAILING INSTALLATION LOCATION – INDICATING DISTANCES FROM PROPERTY LINE, STRUCTURE(S), AND POSSIBLE IGNITION SOURCE IF ANY.
- WORK SHALL NOT PROCEED WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE NRFD CODES/PERMIT INSPECTOR.
- UPON RECEPTION OF APPLICATION, THE NRFD INSPECTOR PERSONNEL WILL INSPECT THE SITE TO DETERMINE IF PROPOSED LPG TANK(S) LOCATION CONFORMS TO NYS CODES, AS WELL AS THE CITY OF NEW ROCHELLE MUNICIPAL CODES BEFORE WORK COMMENCES.
- UPON APPROVAL, THE INSPECTOR MAY RETURN TO THE SITE A MINIMUM OF 3 TIMES TO INSURE ALL FIRE CODES REQUIREMENTS AND COMPLIANCES ARE MET UNTIL WORK IS COMPLETED.
- THERE IS A REOCCURRING FEE THAT THE SITE-OWNER/HOMEOWNER MUST PAY ANNUALLY FOR THE STORAGE AND USE OF LPG.
- ALL GAS PIPING, FITTINGS AND VALVES MUST MEET NYS CODE.
- ALL WORK MUST BE PERFORMED BY A LICENSE PLUMBER.
- ALL WORK TO MEET NYS CODE AND NFPA LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) CODES.
